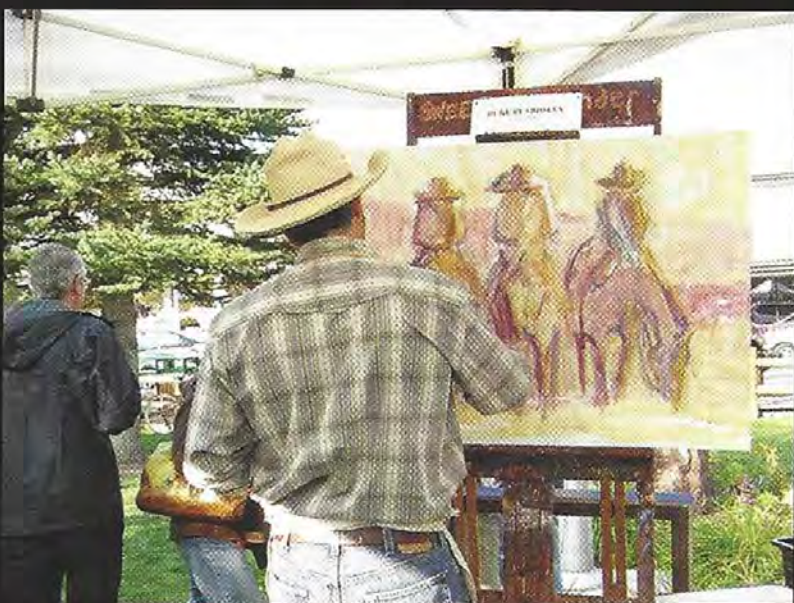
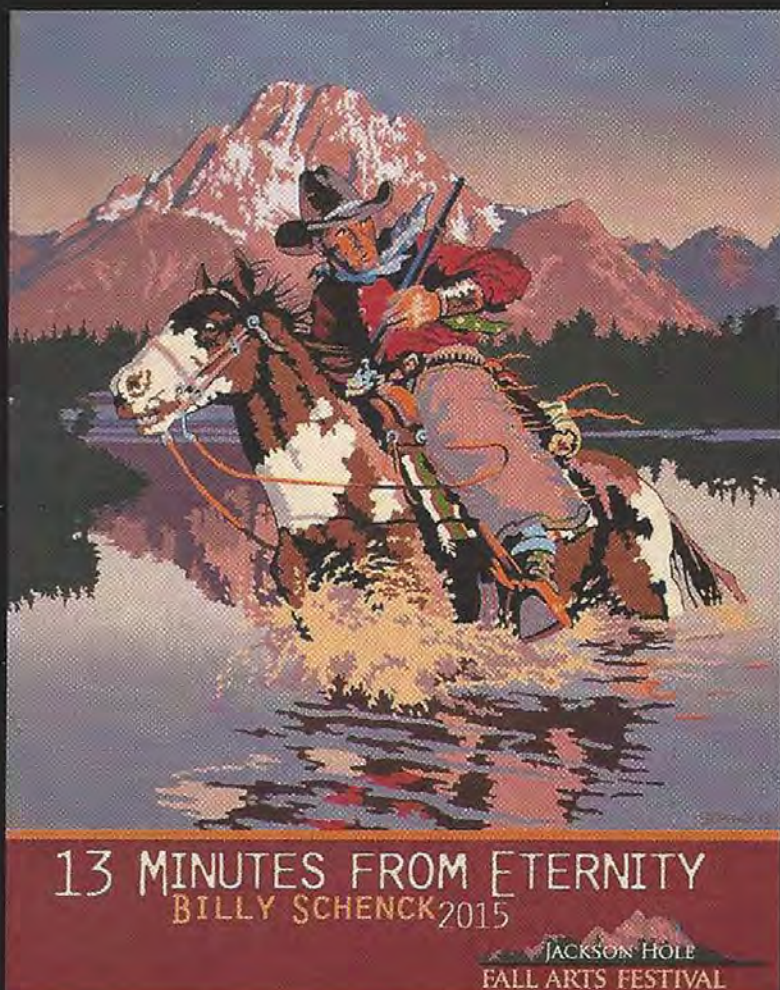

■ Set amidst the splendor of the Tetons, the Jackson Hole Fall Arts Festival is widely recognized as one of the premier cultural events in the Rocky Mountain West. Thousands of art enthusiasts are drawn each year to experience the diverse artwork and breathtaking natural surroundings that make Jackson Hole a leading cultural center. Visitors will appreciate the works of nationally and internationally acclaimed artists along with an exceptional array of events featuring music, cuisine and wine. This 31st annual affair encompasses more than 50 auctions, events and activities throughout downtown Jackson. This year's featured artist is Billy Schenck, whose artwork was also chosen for the very first festival in 1985.

The event kicks off Wednesday, September 9, with the Western Visions: Wild, Wearable, Art, exhibition, followed by the Western Visions: Jewelry & Artisan Show & Sale on September 10. The Western Design Conference opens on September 11, along with the Palates & Palettes Gallery Walk, and the Jackson Hole Art Auction is September 18 and 19. Also during the weekend of September 18 and 19 is the third annual Jackson Hole Showcase of Homes, inviting visitors into some of the most spectacular living spaces in the West. To round out the celebratory month, there will also be historic ranch tours, open-air art fairs, Taste of the Tetons, wine tastings, poster signings, art walks and a quick draw.
